

A booster shot will increase your immune response.

**YOU CAN GET THE PFIZER, MODERNA, OR THE J&J
COVID-19 VACCINE BOOSTER SHOT IF:**

**You're age 12 and older and you received 2 doses
of the Pfizer vaccine over 5 months ago.**

OR

**You're age 18 and older and you received 2 doses
of the Moderna vaccine over 5 months ago.**

OR

**You're age 18 and older and you received
the J&J vaccine over 2 months ago.**

The Pfizer or Moderna vaccine are preferred in most
situations over the J&J vaccine.



Children and teens age 12–17 can *only* get a Pfizer booster shot.

**Adults age 18 and older can choose the Pfizer, Moderna, or J&J COVID-19
vaccine for their booster shot *regardless* of which vaccine they initially received.**

**People should talk to their health care provider about whether a booster shot is
appropriate for them.**



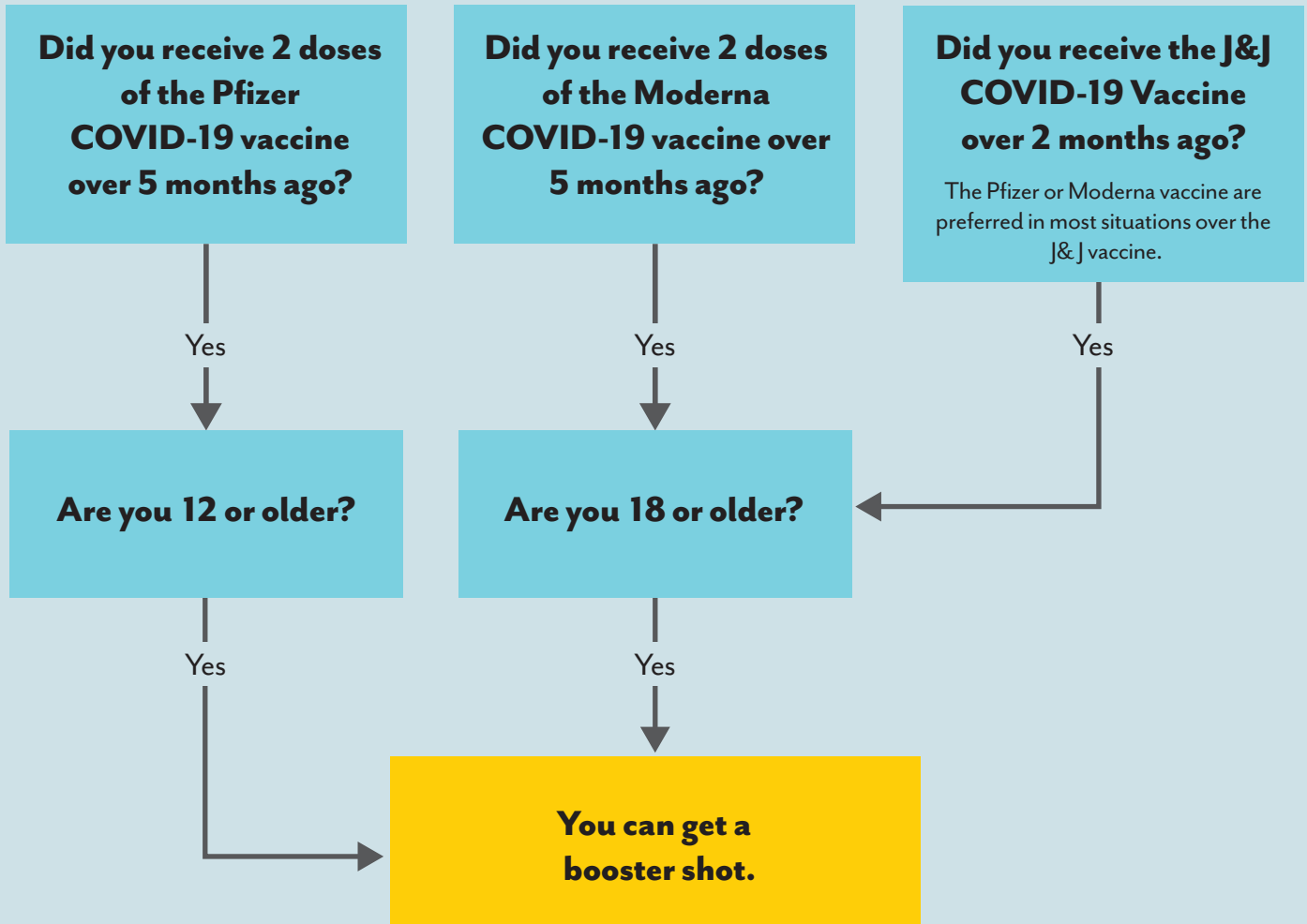

WHO CAN GET A COVID-19 BOOSTER SHOT?



Children and teens age 12–17 can **only** get a Pfizer booster shot.

Adults age 18 and older can choose the Pfizer, Moderna, or J&J COVID-19 vaccine for their booster shot **regardless** of which vaccine they initially received.

People should talk to their health care provider about whether a booster shot is appropriate for them.
